Arrival at the Port: CHECK PORT MAP

- When entering the Port, access through the South access area, take the ticket, and go to the Regatta Office to validate it. You will use the same ticket during all the regatta days. Remember to ask for it during the Race Office opening hours.
- If you come with a road trailer, head to the trailer parking area and use a parking lot. Unload your boats.
- You will have to access the Dinghy Area walking with your boat (check the port map).
- If you need to leave your boat at the Club the days before or after the regatta, please, ask for an authorization at the Regatta Office.
- Please, respect the circulation of vehicles and the areas reserved for parking.
- The Port has changing rooms with restricted access. Contact with Race Office.

Race Office:

Opening hours: Thursday from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. / Friday from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. / Saturday from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. / Sunday from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

- Remember that the Competitors Meeting is mandatory and will be held at 2.30 p.m. on the September 7th at the Dinghy Area.

- The provisional results of each race will be published in the virtual Notice Board as they are finished.
- The overall results and any races modifications will be published at the end of the protest time. If they have to be modified later, it will be done as soon as possible.

- The prize giving ceremony will be held on September 10th at 3:30 p.m. You can check the list of awards on the regatta website.

Security and Conservation:

- All participants and companions are obliged to make good use of the facilities and to maintain order in the launching area, offices and changing rooms, before the regatta, while the boats are still in the water, and in the end of the day: the launching area must be left tidy, the boat properly secured and the nearby area clean.
- With the aim of reducing plastic consumption, a water fountain will be located in the regatta office where participants can re-fill their canteens.
- Due to the emergency drought situation our region is going through, and the restrictions put in place by the local authorities, we inform you that there will be no water available to rinse the boats at the Dinghy Area on a daily basis, except for the last day.
- It's necessary to manage waste responsibly and follow the recommendations established at the collection point.
- All participants and companions are informed that the land and sea area near Club Nàutic L'Escala is close to the Natural Park of Montgrí, Illes Medes and Baix Ter, so it is necessary to reduce the impact of our activity/navigation.
- **In the case of not following the safety and conservation recommendations, the organization may take the necessary measures and, if necessary, sanction the person or persons involved.**
